
Do NOT exceed vehicle manufacture recommended towing capacity. Please check the vehicle's owner manual.

Step 1:

- 1. In rear wheel well, remove (3) M6 bolts securing mud guard in place.
- 2. Remove the side braces on each side by removing (4) M10 bolts securing each side brace.
- 3. Remove (4) M14 bolts securing the tow hook on the driver left side.
- 4. Remove (2) M14 bolts on the passenger side frame.
- 5. Remove (4) M10 nuts securing the bracket to the bumper.
- 6. Remove (2) M10 bolts securing the crossmember to the bottom of bumper.
- 7. Disconnect rear bumper harness and remove the bumper from vehicle.
- 8. Remove factory trailer hitch receiver if equipped.

Step 2:

- 1. Take nut plate and place it into passenger side body frame rail.
- 2. Guild the plate to align the weld nut with holes under the body frame rail.







Step 3:

- 1. With assistance, lift and attach the bumper to frame rail. Secure with (4) M14 \times 30 hex bolts, (4) M14 flat washers, (4) M14 lock washers.
- 2. Tighten M14 hex bolts with 75 ft. lbs. torque.

Note: Driver side is shown, repeat on the passenger side.






Step 4:


- 1. Attach the hitch spacer plate to the rear crossmember.
- 2. Secure the trailer hitch to rear crossmember using (4) M12 \times 110 hex bolts, (8) M12 flat washers, (4) M12 lock washers, (4) M12 hex nuts.
- 3. Tighten M12 hardware with 60 ft. lbs. torque.





Step 5:

- 1. Install (2) D-rings to shackle mounting brackets.
- 2. Reference wiring diagrame shown below. Wire harness is NOT included.
- 3. After the bumper installed, periodic check to ensure all mounting hardware remains secure and tight.
